LEVEL 1 GRADUATION FROM STUDENT TO NOVICE PRACTITIONER STATUS

STEPS/CRITERIA TO GRADUATE FROM STUDENT TO NOVICE PRACTITIONER

You can complete your status as early as the end of the Primary Patterns programme. Students are encouraged early on in their training to do Resonance Repatterning® successfully. The observations and feedback made from the onset of the programme are intended to encourage you, alleviate anxiety, and strengthen your confidence and skills.

Once Novice status has been achieved, the practitioner can immediately commence with their business, charging customers from Novice Practitioner level.

A. HIGH LEVEL OVERVIEW OF PROCESS STEPS TO FOLLOW TO ACHIEVE NOVICE PRACTITIONER

- Qualified Resonance Repatterning Instructor in good standing provides the student with written approval via email that they have completed the requirements and can practice as a practitioner.
- The student writes to support@resonancerepatterning.com and advises that they have received the necessary approvals from the qualified Resonance Repatterning Instructor in good standing and provides such approval.
- The student will then upload the requirements listed under “these are the requirements” and “observations required” below into the designated folder provided by member support.
- The Certification/Quality Assurance team will check the respective documents and videos, provide feedback, and confirm the status as Novice Practitioner.
- The student will then **pay for their Novice Practitioner licence and membership** and provide proof of payment to membersupport@resonancerepatterning.com.
- The student will receive confirmation of their achievement along with the logo to use and certificate of achievement. An electronic certificate will be provided. Should you wish to secure a hard copy certificate, write to support@resonancerepatterning.com, and a certificate will be printed and delivered to you for an additional cost of **\$25 plus courier**.
- Note: You also benefit from receiving an additional accreditation with the American Drugless Practitioners Association/American Alternative Medical Association in the USA, for which the Ravenall Institute and Resonance Repatterning® is accredited.
- The student will then be able to practice as a Novice Practitioner and charge monies for services.
- If it happens that the student still needs additional work and is unable to be approved immediately, the Certification/QA team will provide written feedback to the student, and it is the Instructor’s responsibility with the student to ensure correction.
- Once correction has taken place, the student sends a further communication to support@resonancerepatterning.com, and they will repeat the process.
- After the third attempt, the student will need to obtain further training from the Instructor before repeating the process.

NOTE: There is no additional observation fee if you complete this during the Fundamentals and Primary Patterns programmes. Until you are a Novice Practitioner, you are a student and cannot practice or charge clients.

YOU CANNOT REMAIN WITH THE TITLE OF STUDENT FOR LONGER THAN 12 MONTHS – YOU MUST COMPLETE THIS PROCESS OR RETAKE THE PROGRAMMES.

B. THESE ARE THE REQUIREMENTS TO BE COMPLETED AND UPLOADED INTO THE DESIGNATED ONLINE REPOSITORY PROVIDED TO YOU:

1. Complete the Fundamentals & Primary Patterns programmes either online or face to face.
2. Read both books cover to cover.
3. Complete the skills development assignments in these books as you go through the programmes.
4. Provide a written declaration that you have completed points 2 and 3 above.
5. Provide a copy of your verification of courses taken.
6. Construct a typed-up Excel spreadsheet called “Session Log” at the start of your Fundamentals programme, which records the following information for every session, even short practice sessions.
 - Date, the full name of the person receiving a session, type of session, i.e., in-class practice or out of class practice with friend/family or self-session, name of the session, i.e. orientation etc, length of the session, i.e., minutes/hours, reflection: areas that you feel that you could have done better, areas that you feel you did well, and lastly, any aspects of the session



that you believe may mirror what is going on inside of you. Add each person's email address and telephone number, as we may call a handful to find out about the experience.

- Keep this sheet and carry on adding to it during the course of your journey through your Resonance Repatterning career.
 - Save a copy of each of the session notes.
7. Complete eight (8) full self-sessions and eight (8) full in-class or practice sessions with friends/family/class members. During this, demonstrate the ability to run a session appropriately from Intention, Problems into Opportunities, and Orientation, and hold space for the client. (Full session means the complete repatterning from beginning to end, including an energizing option instead of demonstrating one section).
 8. Complete all the repatternings from Fundamentals and Primary Patterns on yourself.
 9. Highlight the sessions on your "Session Log" that fulfil points 7 and 8 above and upload the session notes from these sessions (these can be anonymous). Obtain written consent from each 'client' to share their session notes for observation purposes and upload these to your online repository.

Observations listed below: Students are also observed during the class by the teacher either live or online during the Repatterning programme to ensure confidence in conducting sessions and demonstrating basic competence.

C. THIS IS THE OBSERVATION PROCESS FOR REPATTERNINGS TO ATTAIN NOVICE PRACTITIONER TO BE UPLOADED ONLINE

1. Students demonstrate each requirement listed below in D plus one of the energizing options from the categories listed in point 5 for each session.
2. These are to be recorded via Zoom or similar technology that can be easily uploaded.
3. All videos must be recorded in gallery view so both the student and their 'client' are visible and their interaction can be observed.
4. All videos must not exceed 1GB in size. Please use an online tool or other software to compress larger videos.
5. Each can be recorded individually, or 2 or 3 can be combined as part of a larger session.
6. Ensure every person that you video has signed a waiver for the information to be used for observation purposes and that their data will be protected as much as is possible but cannot be guaranteed – see your license to practice agreement – and upload a copy to your online repository.
7. Upload the points 1-9 above in B above.

LEVEL 2 GRADUATION FROM NOVICE PRACTITIONER TO PRACTITIONER STATUS

STEPS/CRITERIA TO GRADUATE FROM NOVICE PRACTITIONER TO PRACTITIONER

You can complete this status at the end of the Five Element and Meridian programme. You do not have to achieve Practitioner status before heading to the Certification status. However, We DO recommend that you do, so you can receive feedback on your progress to avoid disappointment in the certification process. After this level, you can continue to complete Advanced Practitioner or go straight to the Certified Practitioner level without completing Advanced.

You do not have to achieve Practitioner or Advanced status first before you go from Novice Practitioner to Certified, HOWEVER, we do recommend that you at least complete Practitioner level, so you can receive feedback on your progress to avoid disappointment.

It is important that you check first that you have met/are able to meet the criteria as listed below under requirements and observations before you start this process

C. THIS IS THE OBSERVATION PROCESS FOR REPATTERNINGS TO ATTAIN PRACTITIONER LEVEL AND TO BE UPLOADED ONLINE

NB. Students can be observed conducting repatternings with an energizing option in person or online by a designated observer approved by the International Institute who is part of the Certification Committee.

This can also be undertaken during a repatterning training process or the student can record sessions privately and submit them.

If undertaken in person – the sessions must still be recorded.

1. Students demonstrate each requirement listed below in D
2. These are to be recorded via Zoom or similar technology that can be easily uploaded.
3. All videos must be recorded in gallery view so both the student and their 'client' are visible and their interaction can be observed.
4. All videos must not exceed 1GB in size. Please use an online tool or other software to compress larger videos.
5. Send a maximum of two recordings with an Energy Constriction Release included, unless the ECR is completed separately as a 3rd recording.
6. The explanation of RR & muscle checking should be included as part of the introduction to a client session.
7. Each can be recorded individually, or 2 or 3 can be combined as part of a larger session.
8. Ensure every person that you video has signed a waiver for the information to be used for observation purposes and that their data will be protected as much as is possible but cannot be guaranteed – see your license to practice agreement – and upload a copy to your online repository.
9. Upload the points 4-10 above in B above.

D. AREAS OF DEMONSTRATION

In addition to an Energy Constriction Release and an explanation of Resonance Repatterning and muscle checking, two (2) repatternings must be demonstrated from the list below:

- With at least one that includes an earlier experience
- And with the use of a Diffusion or Fusion as an energizing option

1. Parental Repatterning
2. Earlier Experience Repatterning
3. Sound Frequency Repatterning
4. Chakra Repatterning with the Earlier Experience



LEVEL 3 GRADUATION FROM PRACTITIONER TO ADVANCED PRACTITIONER STATUS

STEPS/CRITERIA TO GRADUATE FROM PRACTITIONER TO ADVANCED PRACTITIONER

You can complete this status after completing the Basic Series, plus the advanced programmes (see B below).

- Before you can complete this Advanced Practitioner status, you **must have achieved the Practitioner Status**.
- **You do not have to complete this Advanced Practitioner status to go to the Certification status.** You can simply go straight to the Certified Practitioner level without completing Practitioner or Advanced Practitioner.

LEVEL 4 GRADUATION FROM NOVICE PRACTITIONER, OR PRACTITIONER OR ADVANCED PRACTITIONER TO CERTIFIED PRACTITIONER STATUS

STEPS/CRITERIA TO GRADUATE TO CERTIFIED PRACTITIONER

Once you have demonstrated a basic level of proficiency, you can then complete the practitioner certification. **You do not have to achieve Practitioner or Advanced Practitioner status first.** However, we DO recommend that you do so, so you can receive feedback on your progress to avoid disappointment in the certification process. There is no obligation to complete the Certified Practitioner status. However, it is encouraged, **given you are working with the public. This demonstrates** you have achieved an element of mastery in your craft. Clients are drawn to those that have completed mastery. We encourage you to achieve a minimum of Practitioner status because you are always limited in what you charge or draw in by remaining at the Novice, basic level of competency.

The certification can be completed any time on your Resonance Repatterning® journey.

You can complete this status after completing the Basic Series.

6. Provide a written declaration that you have completed points 4 and 5 above.
7. Provide a copy of your verification of courses taken, including retaking the Basic Series.
8. Provide proof of payment of the observation fee of \$350.



9. Continue adding to your “Session Log” spreadsheet that you created at the start of your Fundamentals programme, or construct a “Practitioner Session Log” spreadsheet, which records the following information for every session required in points 9 and 10 below.
 - Date, the full name of the person receiving a session, type of session, i.e., in-class practice or out of class practice with friend/family or self-session, name of the session, i.e. orientation etc, length of the session, i.e., minutes/hours, reflection: areas that you feel that you could have done better, areas that you feel you did well, and lastly, any aspects of the session that you believe may mirror what is going on inside of you. Add each person’s email address and telephone number, as we may call a handful to find out about the experience.
 - Save a copy of each of the session notes.
10. Complete all twenty-six (26) repatterning on yourself.
11. Complete Client sessions: Thirty (30), one-hour sessions given to others, 8 of which **must be** face to face using the manual muscle check.
12. Upload the session notes from points 9 and 10 above (these can be anonymous) and highlight these sessions on your “Session Log”. Obtain written consent from each client to share their session notes for observation purposes and upload these to your online repository.
13. Receive Five (5) one-hour sessions from at least two different Certified Practitioners and upload the notes from these sessions.

Session 2: Mu Point Repatterning with the Colour World Torch PLUS Intention for a New Possibility.

Session 3: Parental Repatterning or Earlier Experience Repatterning including Energy Constriction Release PLUS Fusion or Diffusion, whichever one did not come up during session 1.

You can apply to become a Mentor after completing the Basic Series and becoming a Practitioner.
